




## **Virtual ACR® AIRP® Rad-Path Correlation Course FAQs**

### **Is the registration still open? Are there places still available?**

Yes, unlimited seats available to all virtual courses. Registration ends on the first day of the course.


### **Will the content be online to access whenever it suits me or is it live lectures where I would have to log on at a certain time to watch?**

1. Live lectures (lectures given synchronous online ) will be scheduled 10 - 12 am and 1 - 4 pm (ET).
  - a. These live lectures will be made into recordings () within 48 hours and be uploaded to Canvas for attendees to view/review.
2. Presentations will be given by organ section in the schedule (Pediatric, MSK, GI, etc.)
3. Access to the course lectures (videos) will be limited to the course session until 2 week after course ends. All other materials (handouts, outlines and summaries) can be found in Course Resources  folders and can be downloaded beginning one week before the start of the course until two weeks after the course ends.

### **How long will the online content be accessible upon completion of the course?**

These live lectures will be made into recordings within 48 hours and will remain available to attendees until two weeks after the course ends. Self-paced material is available one week before the course until two weeks after course ends.

### **What do asynchronous/self-paced lectures and content mean?**

Asynchronous are pre-recorded lectures () and include content such as handouts, outlines, and summaries available to registrants one week before the course begins until 2 weeks after the course ends.

### **How is attendance registered?**

All registrants must set up their profile within Canvas. **Note**—*put in your correct time zone when setting up your profile; default is Mountain Standard Time (MST)*. Participation in interactive content, viewing videos, and completing assessments in the Modules section will be monitored and is the basis for receiving a certificate of completion at the end of the course.

### **Is the course graded?**

There must be 75% participation of materials in order to receive a certificate of completion. No material is graded. Grades reflect participation and will tally daily. This can be found in Canvas under “**Grades**”.

### **Will it take four weeks dealing with all the subjects?**

Yes. Live lectures (lectures given live via Zoom) will be scheduled 10 - 12 am and 1 - 4 pm (EST) Monday-Friday for four weeks.

**What if I have technical difficulty viewing the recordings (spinning circle)?**
