
56 year old female with two week history of increasing abdominal pain, nausea and vomiting






Post-contrast abdominal CT imaging shows a soft tissue mass filling and expanding the IVC with contiguous invasion of the right renal vein.






PET-FDG fused CT image shows moderate FDG uptake within the IVC mass, slightly greater than blood pool.





IVC mass extends into the inferior right atrium.






T1W Coronal MRI, post gad

Mass demonstrates heterogeneous enhancement on T1W post contrast study.








T1W Coronal MRI, post gad

Histology reveals fascicles of spindle cells with multiple mitotic figures.


