

Upload Documents Section

Important requirements for ALL uploaded documents (PDF format only) PDF format only :

- Remove all PHI from EACH document. The pathology report is the only document permitted to expose the specimen ID# that matches with the specimen ID# on the slides submitted to the course.
- Remove all medical doctors' names (including pathologists, radiologists, and others), institution names, identifiable report numbers, patient location or room numbers, addresses, phone numbers, etc., etc.
- Only the medical content or diagnosis codes will be remain on submitted reports.

Tools for redaction are Adobe Photoshop or PRO, Microsoft Office Paint, MAC Preview, office white-out, or a permanent marker (must go-over twice).

Required uploaded documents (PDF format only):

- ORIGINAL Pathology report(s) OR autopsy report(s) OR if applicable, BOTH. The original pathology and autopsy reports contain important information that AIRP pathologists use to comprehensively review your submitted slides. Specimen ID#s MUST be exposed and MATCH the slide specimen ID#s (remove PHI).
- Operative report(s) OR procedural report(s) OR if applicable, BOTH (remove PHI)
- Radiology report(s) (remove PHI)
- Discharge summary (OPTIONAL) (remove PHI)
- International cases: You must upload the original document and a translated English version
